About the Report

In 2024, to fully implement China's "carbon peaking and carbon neutrality" strategy, foster new productive forces, display the status quo of TEDA's ESG performance as a crucial part of local investment environment, and strengthen communication with all walks of life, the Tianjin Economic-Technological Development Area (hereinafter referred to as "TEDA" or "the Zone") Administrative Commission compiled and released the TEDA Sustainable Development (ESG) Report(hereinafter referred to as the "Report") according to relevant requirements of the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) Sustainable Development Reporting Standards (G4).

Energy Conservation and Carbon Reduction Efforts for Carbon Peaking and Carbon Neutrality Goals

Expanding Green Energy Supply

TEDA proactively promotes clean energy transformation and energy source substitution, vigorously implements the "coal-replaced-by-gas" projects. Through 2023, TEDA reduced coal consumption by 320,000 tons annually and cut carbon dioxide emissions by 450,000 tons. In 2023, clean energy accounts for over **90%** of TEDA's energy sources. A green energy supply system dominated by wind power and photovoltaic has taken shape. As of the end of 2023, TEDA's cumulative registered photovoltaic installed capacity exceeded **900MW**.

Uplifting Industrial Energy Efficiency

TEDA has carried out in-depth assessment of the responsibility of achieving energy-saving targets among key energy users, and completed energy conservation of 63,500 tons of standard coal in 2023. TEDA proactively promoted pilot program of cleaner production audit at Nangang Industrial Zone. TEDA saw sustained progress in green manufacturing system. As of the end of 2023, TEDA has a total of 30 national-level green factories, 12 national-level green supply chain management enterprises, and 64 Tianjin-level green factories, initially achieving the demonstration effect of regional green manufacturing clustering.

Shaping "Smart" Zero-carbon Zone

TEDA has planned and built two near-zero carbon parks, namely, the Intelligent Unmanned Equipment Industrial Park and the Binhai-Zhongguancun Science Park, striving to take the lead in exploring near-zero carbon practice in fields like green energy, green buildings, green production, green transportation, and carbon sink, and to become a showcase among typical "double carbon" industrial parks.



Resource Conservation for Circular Economy

A High-Standard Water-saving Park

In 2023, TEDA's fresh water consumption per 10,000 yuan of industrial value-added was 3.7 m³, recycled industrial water consumption was 2.862 billion m³, and the reclaimed water utilization rate was 45.50%. The integrated seawater desalination and comprehensive utilization project at Nangang Industrial Zone has started water supply to the region's key projects such as Huadian. Through the year, 21 water-saving enterprises and 4 water-saving communities were recognized. In 2023, TEDA initiated the water management innovation club program, and multiple companies signed sustainable water management innovation proposals.

Proactively Revitalizing Idle Land Resources

In 2023, a ledger involving 87 enterprises and 472.65 hectares of idle industrial land was set up, and approximately 19 hectares of idle land of enterprises were put into active use again to optimize land use efficiency. The TEDA Fashion Plaza renewal project has been fully launched, and the land acquisition and reserve of multiple idle projects has been completed, revitalizing 1.5 billion yuan worth of building assets.

Robust Circular Economy

TEDA always strives to shape an industrial symbiosis system and energy cycle chains. So far, circular economy industrial chains dominated by automobile manufacturing, electronics & communications, biology & health, new energy, energy supply & water cycle, have taken shape. A circular economy information service platform is already in place, which effectively promoted resource utilization capacity.

Proactively Shaping "Waste-free Enterprises"

In 2023, TEDA issued the "Notice on Carrying out the Creation of Waste-Free Enterprises" to encourage enterprises to start relevant pilot programs. FAW-Volkswagen Tianjin Branch was identified as TEDA's 2023 "waste-free enterprise", and 10 enterprises such as Tianjin Minth Machinery were identified as TEDA's 2023 "waste-free enterprises" pilot projects.



Stepping up Green Infrastructure and Propelling Green Renewal

Promoting green upgrades of environmental infrastructures

TEDA currently has 5 waste water treatment plants, 1 domestic waste treatment plant, and 3 hazardous waste treatment plants, with a number of infrastructure projects such as Binhai Hazardous Waste Treatment & Disposal Center and facilities for electronic product disassembly and waste lead-acid battery disposal, etc. in operation.

Showcase for Low-carbon Green Buildings

TEDA promotes the large-scale development of green buildings and implements 100% green building standards for new buildings. A regional green building cluster represented by TEDA MSD and Yujiapu Financial and Business District has been completed, with high-star-rated green buildings represented by Tianjin Carbon Peaking and Carbon Neutrality Building as landmarks. In 2023, **29** new green building projects were finished, increasing the floor area of green buildings by **1.054** million m².

Adoption of New Energy Transport Vehicles

In 2023, TEDA's earliest batch of smart mobile charging piles were put into use at the Tianhe Digital Industrial Park. All buses in its built-up areas have been replaced with new energy vehicles, and the world's first batch of 100 methanol-hydrogen electric buses were put into use, using methanol as vehicle range-extending fuel to achieve "near-zero" carbon dioxide emission.

Optimized Environment Performance for a Beautiful TEDA

Quality of local atmospheric environment was stable and improving. In 2023, the PM_{2.5} concentration at state-monitored points in TEDA was 40µg/m³, and the proportion of days with excellent air quality was 67.4%. **Quality of surface water was stably up-to-standard.** In 2023, the average water quality of the Yongding Xinhe River Tanghan Highway Bridge reached Class III, average cross-section water quality of the Jiyunhe River Tidal Gate and the East Open Drainage Channel reached Class IV, and the average cross-section water quality of the Haihe River Gate reached Class V, meeting 100% of the annual assessment indicators. **Living environment is lush, green and beautiful.** As of the end of 2023, TEDA's green area reached 31.753 million square meters, with 31 parks and 4.37 million trees. The West Zone Twin-Cities Green Corridor project has been implemented to create an ecological buffer zone organically connecting the Tianjin downtown and Binhai downtown in all directions.

Precise Prevention and Control of Pollution for Blue Sky and Clear Water

A Lasting Battle of Pollution Prevention and Control

In 2023, interactive action for precise air quality control was carried out. A 100-day campaign was launched during autumn and winter. Altogether 4 orange warnings and 1 yellow warning for heavy pollution weather and 13 adverse weather responses were activated. Coordinated water quality management saw visible progress, with up-to-standard rate of treated waste water discharged to the sea reaching 95.2%, up-to-standard rate of rainwater discharged to the sea 97.6%, and up-to-standard rate of discharged water from waste water plants 100%. Through 2023, comprehensive utilization rate of industrial solid waste was 90.9%, and centralized disposal rate of hazardous waste was

100%. The TEDA model for household waste classification was reported to the Ministry of Housing and Urban Rural Development as a typical successful case from Tianjin.

Selected as a Pilot Zone for Collaborative Innovation of Pollution Reduction and Carbon Reduction

In 2023, TEDA was selected as one of China's first batch of pilot cities and industrial parks for collaborative innovation in pollution reduction and carbon reduction. It is the only selected zone from Tianjin. TEDA strives to create a "TEDA Model" for collaborative innovation management in pollution reduction and carbon reduction.

Innovation Efforts in Environmental Management of POPs and Toxic and Harmful Chemicals

TEDA has established a full life-cycle management platform for POPs and toxic and harmful chemicals. As of the end of 2023, the platform has covered more than 30 relevant key enterprises in the region. In October 2023, TEDA received the AA recognition of the *Code for Ecological Benefit Evaluation of Industrial Parks*, becoming the first industrial park in China to obtain such recognition.

Strengthening Climate Resilience for Future Risks

Ever-improving Monitoring and Early Warning Capabilities Against Climate Change

In 2023, TEDA strengthened its capacity as a climate-resilient city. The coverage rate of automatic meteorological observation stations related to climate change reached 100%. The urban intelligent governance support system to adapt to climate change has initially taken shape. The comprehensive supervision platform for flood control system is under construction. The data neural network of the "City Brain" has become stronger.

An Ever-improving Sponge City

In 2023, TEDA successfully coordinated the "sponge city building initiative" throughout the region. A total of 26 ponding points were rectified and eliminated. The cumulative annual utilization of rainwater resources was 1.69 million cubic meters. Up-to-standard area as a "sponge city" reached 46.45 square kilometers, with up-to-standard rate at 47.87%. TEDA won the 2023 Tianjin Binhai New Area Sponge City Building Self-Assessment Report Quality Assessment Award.

An Active Participator in International Cooperation on Climate Change

In June 2023, TEDA and the World Wide Fund for Nature (Switzerland) Beijing Representative Office signed *Strategic Cooperation Memorandum* to jointly build the "Green Development Research and Exchange Cooperation Project for Industrial Parks". In July 2023, TEDA joined the World Economic Forum's "Transitioning Industrial Clusters towards Net Zero" initiative, becoming China's first national-level development zone to join the initiative.

Protecting Biodiversity for a Beautiful World

Positive Progress in Ecological Restoration

Ecological restoration projects along the coastline of Nangang Industrial Zone saw visible progress. As of the end of 2023, TEDA has completed the construction of about 7.5 hectares of artificial emission reduction wetlands, 3.15 km² of ecological greenways, 8.6 kilometers of ecological seawalls, and 10.2 kilometers of ecological corridors. The ecological restoration observation station has been established. Throughout 2023, proliferation and artificial releasing of 10.4 million marine creatures was completed.

Robust Local Economy with New Growth Drivers

High-quality Growth Carrying On

Throughout 2023, TEDA's economy saw steady and dynamic growth. The regional GDP reached 247.926 billion yuan, a year-on-year increase of 3.2%. The total output value of industrial enterprises above designated size reached 541.22 billion yuan, and the added value of industrial enterprises above designated size increased by 1.3%. The actual utilization of foreign capital was US\$1.28 billion, and the actual utilization of domestic capital was 70.01 billion yuan, a year-on-year increase of 24.1%.

Growth of leading industries was eye-catching

Over the years, TEDA has been extending its industrial chains vertically and expanding its industrial clusters horizontally, with a fully-fledged and high-quality "4+1" industrial structure in place. In 2023, the total output value of TEDA's four leading industries, namely, auto and high-end equipment, next-gen information technology, new chemical materials, and healthcare reached 487.34 billion yuan, accounting for 90% of its total output value of industrial enterprises above designated size.

Promising Green Industries

TEDA attaches great importance to the development of green industries and continues to build green industry demo bases. In 2023, revenue of green industries exceeded 100 billion yuan, with added value of green industries accounting for more than 20%.



Hi-tech Innovation Bringing about New Productive Forces

Innovation ecosystem continues to improve

TEDA has successively issued supportive policies such as *10 Measures for the Encouragement of Hi-tech Innovation in TEDA* and *16 Measures for the Encouragement of Hi-tech Innovations in TEDA* to uplift its indigenous innovation capacity. In 2023, TEDA drafted the *Implementation Plan for Fostering New Productive Forces in TEDA*, giving full play to its role as a national entrepreneurship and innovation demo base and creating more momentum for innovation. In 2023, TEDA released the *Plan for Building Intellectual Property Rights Operation Center in TEDA*, and was approved as one of China's pilot zone for innovation in commercial secret protection.

The Pooling of Innovative Entities Accelerates

In 2023, the total number of national-level high-tech enterprises in TEDA reached 1,142. The number of Eagle Enterprises reached 651, and that of Gazelle Enterprises and hi-tech leading (in cultivation) enterprises reached 60 and 55 respectively. More innovation platforms emerged. By 2023, the number of national-level R&D institutions in TEDA reached 25, the total number of engineering technology centers, engineering research centers, enterprise-owned technology centers and key labs at or above provincial level reached 180. TEDA is also home to 13 national-level incubators and 26 municipal-level incubators.

Colorful Cultural Activities & Sophisticated Education System

Colorful Cultural Activities

Throughout 2023, TEDA has successfully held a series of cultural, tourism, business and entertainment activities and fostered multiple brand-name events including the 2023 Binhai Light Festival, TEDA Spring Life Festival, Dragon Boat Race, Juilliard Piano Art Festival, etc. Throughout the year, TEDA welcomed 5 million counts of tourists and kept on building a business environment with humanistic appeal.

High-quality and Diversified Educational Services

In 2023, there were 40 compulsory education schools in TEDA, with a total enrollment of 4500 children in kindergartens and 20000 students in primary and secondary schools. Compulsory education enrollment rate was 100% with consolidation rate at 100% and the "direct promotion" model from primary school to junior high school has been guaranteed. In 2023, construction of a batch of new schools such as Yaohua Middle School Binhai Campus, East China Normal University TEDA School and TEDA Yueyang Road Primary School accelerated.

Equitable and Inclusive Society

Upgrading Human Resources Service Guarantee System

In 2023, construction of Binhai Human Resources Park picked up speed, introducing 70 human resources institutions of various types, with revenue exceeding 3.47 billion yuan. Altogether 108,000 new jobs were created, 89 "Talent Platinum Cards" were issued throughout the year, and 39,000 "Binhai Talent Service Certificates" were issued. 64 "Haihe Craftsman" enterprise training centers and 23 private vocational training institutions were set up.

Improvement of Social Security Service System

In 2023, "TEDA HR" smart human resources and social security system was optimized, with over 33,000 registered users, over 500,000 handling transactions, and service integration rate exceeding 70%. Universal participation of social insurance proceeded, with information of 20,615 uninsured persons verified. Barrier-free environment building saw visible progress. As of the end of 2023, the rate of barrier-free facilities in transportation hubs, various public buildings, new residential quarters, and residential buildings in TEDA reached 100%.

Colorful Mass Organization Activities

In 2023, more than 1,700 trade unions have been established in TEDA, covering 5668 enterprise, with 148,000 individual members. A total of 3,800 trade union activities were carried out, serving 210,000 employees. For the first time, a service matrix with the brand name of "It's good to have you in TEDA" was released. TEDA Women's Federation carried out 11 "Lanxin Women's Care" psychological classes and 4 "Lanxin Care" public welfare activities, serving more than 400 children. TEDA Youth League Committee organized 40,000 people to participate in the "Youth Learning" event throughout the year.

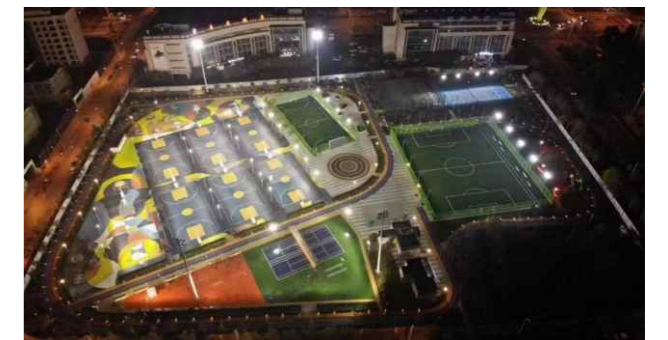
All-round Healthcare

Strengthened Medical Service Guarantee

In 2023, there were 100 medical and health service institutions in TEDA, including 10 general hospitals, 3 specialized hospitals, 48 other medical institutions run by social forces, 1 community health service center, 8 community health service stations, and 30 corporate health care stations. There were 2,377 health technicians and 989 doctors, 309 of whom holding senior professional titles. There were 1,160 hospital beds, with 2.0489 million counts of patients were diagnosed and treated throughout the year.

Building Public Fitness Service System

As of 2023, there were 857 sports venues in TEDA Sub-district, with total area of sports venue at 892,900 square meters, i.e., a per capita sports venue area of 4.46 square meters, and a total of 121 sports institutions (including 56 off-campus sports training institutions, 17 swimming pools, and 1 diving pool) and 22 indoor gyms.

Livable Communities & Quality Life

Remarkable Improvement in Community Service

There are currently 20 communities in TEDA Sub-district, covering 164 residential areas. There are now 202 social workers, 193 of whom hold bachelor's degrees or above and 23 are national-level social workers (intermediate level). TEDA now has 2 childcare centers, 1 psychological counseling center, and 1 resident service station. Warner Community's "Gathering Social Forces for a New Model of Community Co-building" which is highlighted by a 15-minute life circle has been selected as a successful case in the *Casebook for Urban 15-minute Convenient Life Circle* compiled by the Ministry of Commerce.

Elderly Care Services of Warmth and Comfort

As of the end of 2023, there were more than 15,000 elderly people over the age of 60 in TEDA Sub-district. A three-level service system of "1 nursing home, 1 service centers and multiple daycare stations" for the elderly has been set up, comprised of TEDA Nursing Home, No.1 Comprehensive Elderly Care Service Center and multiple Day Care Stations. Elderly care has basically reached every senior citizen in TEDA.

Strong Sense of Social Responsibility

Contribution to China's Rural Revitalization

In 2023, TEDA and Tongren City, Qinghai Province consecutively built 2 "Rural Revitalization Demo Villages", and initiated a donation program entitled "Contributing to Rural Revitalization and Jointly Drawing a Concentric Circle" which raised more than 4.9 million yuan from nearly 100 companies.

Solid Work in Pairing Assistance

In 2023, TEDA actively guided local enterprises to invest and start businesses in Huangnan Prefecture, Qinghai Province to deepen cooperation between the two regions. Investment from TEDA enterprises has been added to a total of 10 million yuan. Tianjin Climate Exchange from TEDA signed a cooperation framework agreement with Huangnan Prefecture to make full use of its advantages via the carbon trading platform to empower the forest, grassland and wetland ecological resources of Huangnan Prefecture.

Substantial Social Welfare Services

As of the end of 2023, the TEDA Social Service Volunteer Association has registered 163 volunteer service teams, and the "TEDA Social Service" applet had a registration volume of more than 13,000 volunteers, with volunteer service time totaling 19,605.5 hours. The TEDA Charity Association had a total annual donation expenditure of 5.3617 million yuan. In 2023, the Association won the "Outstanding Charity Organization Award" during Tianjin's first Charity Award election.

Scientific and Fully-fledged Industry Policy System

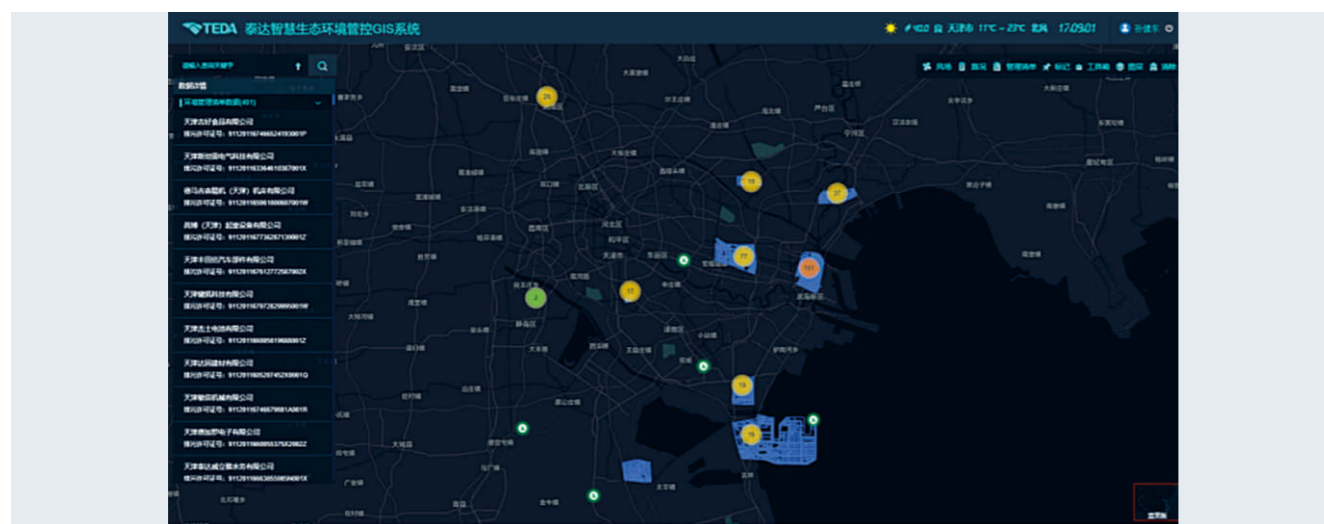
As of 2023, TEDA has built up a "2+2+N" industrial policy system for high-quality development, and proactively facilitates the growth of advanced manufacturing and modern services, fully promotes innovation, accelerates the gathering of talents, and supports the development needs of enterprises in a multi-faceted and all-round way.

Green Development Policies Effectively Implemented

In 2023, the *TEDA Carbon Peak Implementation Plan* was released. According to the *Comprehensive Evaluation Plan for Green Development Level of Industrial Enterprises in TEDA (Trial)*, 30 enterprises were commended. Throughout the year, in accordance with the *Interim Measures for Promoting Green Development in TEDA*, TEDA reviewed and approved support for 42 energy conservation and environmental protection projects, and allocated 14.704 million yuan of funds.

Green Supervision Mechanism Gradually Perfected

A green access mechanism for entry into the zone was established. Energy conservation review system for fixed asset investment projects was strictly implemented. Energy consumption permission review for projects with high energy consumption or high emission was prudently performed. In 2023, TEDA optimized the efficiency of environmental impact assessment approval and served as Tianjin's pilot zone for "two-in-one approval" for environmental impact assessment and pollution discharge permits. The "Internet + Environmental Protection" off-site supervision model was created, ecological environment GIS platform was upgraded, and dynamic supervision of environmental supervision and point-to-point tailored services for enterprises was realized.



TEDA Smart Ecological Environment Supervision GIS System

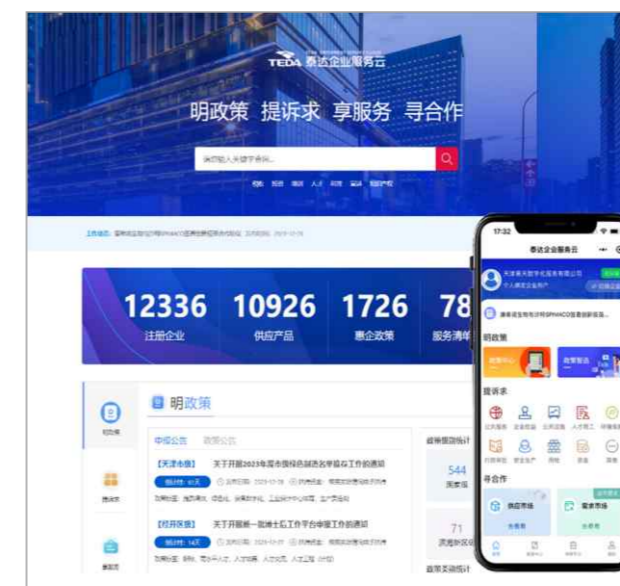
More Sustainable Business Operation under World-class Business Environment

A Galaxy of Green Service Institutions

As of the end of 2023, there are 153 third-party green service institutions in TEDA, among which 43 are engaged in low-carbon services, energy-saving renovation and new energy services, accounting for 28% of the total. Representative institutions include Tianjin TEDA EcoCenter, Tianjin Binhai New Area Environmental Innovation Research Institute, etc.

High-quality and Efficient Government Services

In 2023, reform for the approval streamlining of construction projects in TEDA saw visible progress, government services became smarter, and the "one center, multiple outlets" service system took shape at a faster pace. Throughout the year, application acceptance rate at service counters was 100%, on-time completion rate was 100%, and satisfaction rate was more than 98%. TEDA Government Service Website and TEDA One-stop Service Website were elected as China's Leading Government Service Website and one of China's top 10 innovation cases of "Internet + Government Services" respectively for 2023.

Smart Technology Empowers Enterprise Service

In 2023, Phase II of the "TEDA Enterprise Service Cloud" platform was officially launched as a comprehensive enterprise service platform with five major sections, namely, Policies Serving Enterprises, Government-enterprise Connection, Supply-demand Platform, Activity center, and Business Environment. As of the end of 2023, 12,336 companies have been registered on the platform, 1,726 policies have been issued, more than 10,000 products have been recorded on the platform with page view volume of more than 2 million counts.

Robust Green Finance for Carbon Trading

TEDA's green finance is robust and efficient. In 2023, the cumulative transaction volume of carbon quota in the TEDA reached 8.56 million tons, with a transaction value of 340 million yuan. Cumulative transaction volume on the CCER China Certified Emission Reduction market was 2.81 million tons. Innovation of green finance products was also active. In 2023, TEDA witnessed China's first "sustainable linkage" business of financial leasing and the country's first transition finance business, achieving a carbon quota repurchase financing business volume of over 50 million yuan.

Building on Trust via Open and Transparent Information Release

Channels for government information disclosure were consolidated

TEDA strictly standardized the proactive disclosure of government information and disclosure on applications, and formulated the *Guidelines for the Disclosure of Government Information by TEDA Administrative Commission*, ensuring the release of relevant information through the TEDA government service platform's direct link to various government departments, government service new media, TEDA's press conferences, newspapers, radio, television and other media.

Regular Disclosure of Fiscal & Tax Revenue and Expenditures

In 2023, TEDA saw a full-caliber fiscal revenue of 54.384 billion yuan, an increase of 9.1% over the previous year, of which tax revenue accounted for 48.044 billion yuan (an increase of 8.2%). TEDA-level general public budget revenue was 13.908 billion yuan, an increase of 11.6%. Total fiscal expenditure for the year was 19.637 billion yuan, of which the general public fiscal budget expenditure accounting for 12.738 billion yuan.

Upgrading and Optimizing the Smart Environmental Information Platform

TEDA's smart environmental protection platform optimizes nine "ecology + business" environmental scenarios, empowers environmental management and enterprise services, and realizes "butler-style" enterprise-specific environmental archives, online environmental approval, visualized dynamic handheld management, and fully integrated data center functions. In 2023, there was a total of 621,121 operations of various types via the platform.

Minimizing Compliance Risks and Guaranteeing Safety Baseline

Creating Efficient Management System

TEDA has passed the certification for ISO14001 environmental management system and ISO9001 quality management system, and effectively optimized the systematic, scientific and standardized quality management capabilities of its Administrative Commission. TEDA attaches great importance to ESG management and has established an ESG management system framework led by one Vice Chairman of TEDA Administrative Commission with TEDA Ecological Environment Bureau as implementation workforce and other TEDA departments as working members to ensure efficient operation of TEDA's ESG management system.

Strict Prevent and Control against Financial Risks

In 2023, 323 review items were processed. 9 commercial factoring enterprises and 5 financial leasing enterprises were included into the regulatory whitelist. Rectification of 75 enterprises proceeded. Throughout the year, more than 600 financial service-related complaints and 29 risk clues were handled, and over 100 regulatory-purposed interviews, visits and investigations were conducted. 5 anti-illegal fundraising campaigns were carried out. In 2023, the International Commercial Court opened.

Anti-corruption and Clean Government Building

In 2023, TEDA fully implemented its responsibility of comprehensive self-disciplining of local party organizations, correcting the "four bad working styles (formalism, bureaucratism, hedonism and extravagance)", explaining *Civil Law* based on practical cases. TEDA produced a warning film entitled "When Bottom Line Is Broken", and showed it to more than 1,800 people. TEDA held a promotion meeting and warning education conference for continuous purification of the political ecology, and carried out a "warning education month" campaign called "Keeping Alarm Bell Ring, Safeguarding the Bottom Line for Integrity, and Serving the People". TEDA strictly implemented the requirements of bidding laws and regulations, issued disciplinary inspection and supervision recommendations in a targeted manner, and urged relevant agencies with irregularities to fulfill its responsibilities.

Strengthening Emergency Management and Prevention

Throughout 2023, TEDA has been promoting the application of comprehensive emergency management platform in an orderly manner and urged local enterprises to conduct emergency 222 drills. 25 special rectification campaigns for hidden dangers involving production safety were carried out. Various departments inspected a total of 7,692 enterprises and mobilized 16,980 inspectors. TEDA Flood Control Office sent a total of 532 early warnings, responded to 18 rainfalls during the flood season, and activated flood control incident response service 8 times..
